

As writers we will be...

Learning to adapt our writing to suit two different text types. They are a playscript and an argument text. This will give us the chance to practise our skills at writing creatively and descriptively as well as in a non-fiction more factual style. We will learn the features for both style of text and continue to develop our confidence with a range of grammatical features ensuring our sentences make sense and contain a variety of punctuation. We will be exploring different texts to help build our writing and to provide us with model examples to help us understand how these pieces of writing are formed.

As mathematicians we will be...

Developing our understanding of measurement thinking specifically about calculating the perimeter of shapes using the given measurements. We will spend a vast majority of the term looking at multiplication and division thinking about different written methods for these calculations. This will help us to be able to solve more complex problems.

In MFL we will be...

Learning how to say different dates including our birthdays. We will also learn key vocabulary for personal descriptions and then use these to describe ourselves and our friends. We will also get chance to look at some French stories and to learn some more French phonetic sounds.

As artists we will be...

Looking at watercolour painting and linking this to the rainforest. We will consider how to make shades of colour and how to do observational drawings. We will combine both of these to produce a composition.

As scientists we will be...

Learning about States of matter. Within this, we will be thinking about the particle model and how each substance is made up of particles. We will be looking at solids, liquids and gases and their properties. We will also learn about the processes of change between different substances.

As religious explorers we will be...

Looking at a unit called 'How do people think about poverty, justice and self-sacrifice. We will look at what these terms mean and how they are important for religious people and also non-religious people. We will consider how these opinions impact the way people live their life..

As musicians we will be...

Learning how to play the guitar with our specialist music teacher. We will continue to think about the cords and play these confidently along to songs. We will also begin to think about creating our own music using the guitars and in small groups.

As athletes we will be...

Learning to be talented netball players in our outdoor PE sessions. We will develop our ability to control the pass the ball using the three main passes and also to try and get the ball in the net to gain points.. In our indoor PE sessions we will be doing dance where we will develop our skills from previous years. We will create our own dance routines thinking about the different movements, levels and also how it can flow
