Continuing to develop our handwriting and presentation and our understanding and knowledge of the different types of sentence structures and their effects. We will be completing a 'Mystery Write' where we will build suspense through empty words and short snappy sentences. We will also be focusing on relative clauses, repetition for effect, complex sentences, adverbial phrases and rich, appropriate vocabulary.

As mathematicians, we will be...

Building on our multiplication and division knowledge as we continue our first fractions unit where we will be comparing, ordering, adding and subtracting a range of different fractions.

As religious explorers, we will be...

Further developing our knowledge of the Hindu Dharma. We will gain an understanding that the Dharma is a sacrifice that all Hindus undertake. We will look at texts as a source of information to understand Dharma. We'll study characters who are trying to fulfil their Dharma.

As designers we will be...

Creating an interactive display using a range of components which sense sound, light and motion. We will program devices which will respond to our commands

Exploring the Romans and the impact they have had on the world. We will look at when and where they lived, the rulers of Ancient Rome, their beliefs and their inventions.

As scientists, we will be...

Focusing on physics and learning all about energy. We will look at energy transference and the storage of energy. We look find out about fuel as chemical energy stores and how energy is transferred in food chains. We will also understand how energy is transferred in electrical circuits.

In PSHE, we will be...

Celebrating difference within our own culture and the culture of others. We will look at racism, bullying (both direct and indirect) and understanding that we all have a place in this world.

As athletes, we will be...

Developing our rugby knowledge and honing our ball handling skills while focusing on the ABC's (agility, balance and coordination) of sports. We will use tactics to allow us to work as a team for us to be successful.
